		Benadryl/generic diphenhydramine HCl 12.5mg or 25mg oral tablets or liquid according to label instructions for age and weight of person	Minor allergic reactions - call district nurse and/or parent if this needs to be given - follow district epinephrine/anaphylaxis procedure
		Bacitracin Zinc ointment (bacitracin zinc USP 500 units), Neosporin/triple antibiotic ointment (Bacitracin zinc 400 units, Neomycin sulfate equivalent to 3.5mg neomycin base, Polymyxin B sulfate 5000 units)	Topical first aid antibiotic
		Waterjel First Aid Burn Cream (benzalkonium Chloride 0.13%, Lidocaine HCl 0.5%)	Topical for minor burns
	Waterjel Cool Jel (water, melaleuca alternifolia (tea tea), leaf oil, glycerin, propylene glycol, diazolidinyl urea, methylparaben, proplyparaben, triethanolamine, carbomer, acrylates/C10-30 Alkyl acrylate crosspolymer, disodium EDTA, octoxynol-9)	Topical for minor burns	
		Calamine clear/anti-itch lotion (pramoxine HCl 1%, Zinc acetate 0.1%)	Topical for itchy rashes
		Calamine lotion - calamine topical suspension, USP (Calamine 8%, Zinc Oxide 8%)	Topical for itchy rashes

Cough drops (oral): (menthol 5mg-7.5mg)	Sore throats, throat irritation
Hydrocortisone cream USP 1%	Topical for itchy rashes
First aid antiseptic: Benzalkonium Chloride 0.13%	First aid antiseptic
Hydrogen peroxide topical solution USP 3%	For cleaning body piercings, first aid antiseptic
Sterile isotonic buffered eye-wash	For irrigating the eye for foreign body such as dust, etc
Sting & bite relief (benzocaine 20%, menthol 1%)	Topical for insect bites
Sunblock	Prevent sunburn
Vaseline/petroleum jelly	Dry skin
Refresh Lubricant eye drops (carboxymethylcellulose sodium 0.5%)	Eye lubricant
